How I met Christ & How He Helps Me.

When I was a child I used to cry myself to sleep most nights. I was the youngest of seven and thought I was always in the way and no one cared about what I had to say or what I wanted to do. I was often teased, and although it may have been in good humor I took it as hurtful. We had a new pastor who preached about salvation and mother, feeling that life was hard & that she could use God's help, knelt in the kitchen of our very small house which was under construction, and asked him to save her. She had a little lamb that she used to teach Sunday school and I wanted it very badly but she would not give it to me. I was in a fire with third degree burns to my head and when I was in the hospital she gave me the lamb. I accepted Christ and talked to Him, about all my problems, but felt like it was "me and God against the world". I had a relationship with God through several moves and our family even served as staff at a Christian camp.

Throughout high school and college I relied on Him to help me emotionally. I tried Physical Therapy because it sounded good, but could not pass the physics course. During a quiet time I felt God called me to be a Nurse. Because of not trusting people or fear of authority, I was dishonest, putting my best foot forward and hiding what I did not know. At the end of a four year program which took me five years to work through, I failed one 12 credit course, was told I would never make a good Nurse and all of my hopes and dreams seemed unattainable. I realized at that time, that because I was trying to take care of everyone else and not spending time talking to God or listening to Him, our relationship was almost nonexistent. Life was hired and I needed God. I recommitted to Him and got baptized.

The next year I finished a practical nursing program, got married, worked, and conceived a daughter. Soon we took in my husband's sister's children for six months, moved and had a son. There was stress in my relationships and although I was going to church it was not a healthy one and I was not receiving but almost always giving. I wondered about first Corinthians 13 and where the love was. Counseling helped me to look at some things I had buried in my emotions when I had tried to forgive people but had not dealt with the pain those experiences caused. I learned how to be honest emotionally and to grieve and to balance giving and receiving. Going to the same person consistently was essential in helping me be closer to God and to others. It helped me not to be so distant with men. A sponsor and a prayer partner helped me be able to trust healthy women.

Eventually God led me to work in jail ministry. He helps me and all of my relationships.

### My Relationship With Christ

I grew up with great parents, in a family with three older brothers and an older sister. I grew up going to church and learning about Jesus Christ. I thought it was a Christian, and maybe I was, and maybe God what are forgiven me because of

my innocence or my causal relationship with Him. But in my mind, I wasn't a Christian; or rather I wasn't living for Christ. I was the good kid who obeyed my parents, did chores and was kind to people I met But I was fake. You see, I grew up learning how to be two-faced. I was kind and nice and did the 'right' thing when people were around, but I was secretly living only for myself. I acted out of a selfish desire to appear 'good'. I wanted people to think it was a great person, at least a good person, but when I was alone, I was a self-centered monster. I think I had good intentions, but I really wasn't focused on God. I wanted to please Him, and even work hard at doing good things, but I didn't put an effort into praying, or seeking a real relationship with my proposed savior Jesus Christ. With my laziness, I allowed the center of my life to revolve around my own desires, and allowed myself to fall, rather than to chase after God with my life. You see, even though I was a 'kind' person who really didn't get into trouble, knowing God and being a Christian isn't about the things you do or how bad they are. The evil things I did sins, which in God's eyes are as evil and detestable as the 'worst' things people can do. Olsson's are equally as bad in God's eyes. By his grace though there is hope.

I had been going regularly to Youth Group at my church, but really hadn't given God my all. One weekend, another Youth group held at the retreat in our building, I was invited to join in the activities. I was fourteen.

After worship, their pastor talked about our relationship with Christ that put everything aside to follow Him & chase Him with everything a person has. I had heard about this my whole life, and had even tried to do so, but I knew I had a choice to make. I wasn't living entirely for Him, and I decided that enough was enough; I would give my life to God and seek Christ with all that I am. Since then I have been living as much as I can for Him, but it is a continuous and conscious decision any given day to follow Him. As we all do, I haven't quite been able to do that, and I still fail God by sinning from time to time.

But He has saved me by His grace, and the sacrifices Jesus Christ made for me makes up for those failings of mine, as long as I continue to talk with Him and seek Him. I've learned that if I don't constantly seek Him & pray regularly, I can easily fall back to my selfish habits.

Later when I was 18 years old, my doctor diagnosed me with Bipolar disorder, which was confirmed by a psychologist. That was a long and difficult struggle, where I questioned reality and what I knew and believed. However, I continued to pray, being honest with God about all my feelings and disappointments. He helped me to learn to rely on Him, as He is the most real thing in the universe. Over time, and with a lot of God's help, I have grown, been gradually healed, and I now have a life essentially un-disturbed by bipolar disorder. I am back to my usual, if not entirely normal, self. God has helped me to grow, rely on Him, and find peace from the uncertainties and problems of our life in this world. I've found that constant prayer, intentional decisions to seek God, and Godly friends, are essential to living for God, especially good friends. I have grown up with a group of guys in a bible study who were always there to encourage me, to pray for me, and generally keep going in the right direction. I was lucky to have a good family also. That constant encouragement and reminders from brothers and sisters in Christ is what helped to where I am today.

I had always make fun of anyone or anything having to do with God. The thought occurred to me, What if you are wrong?" I realized I could be wrong about God. If you are there, help me! As I called out, even though I did not know who He was, the Holy Spirit met with a warm presence that lasted for a couple of hours. I reasoned that my choices had not gotten me very far and it would be wise to do whatever God asked me.

My counselor asked me to go to Minnesota for another treatment. "She's crazy, I thought - I'm not going. It's cold there and they have a football team that cannot win a Super-bowl!" But as I walked out of the office God reminded me I had told Him I would do as He asked. I went and while there, one of the patients told me about the Christ and I started reading the New Testament. When I read it, I realized this was the grace and mercy I had received when I did not deserve it.

In the last 32 years, God in Grace has helped me to follow the 12 steps, become a counselor, start my own business lead a jail ministry, become a director at two treatment centers, maintain a home and raise a family.
