

Lies and truth

This is a list of the summaries of each time Jesus said I tell you or guarantee this truth, or one of his followers said I am telling the truth. If a concept is listed in one of the books (example Matthew) and repeated in a second one (like Mark or John) I have only put it in here once. Since Jesus prayed that God sanctifies us and we sanctify ourselves with His words of truth, I suggest reading and praying through this list to let God use His words to help us be cleansed, set apart for Him and grow in His truth.

From Matthew

- The story goes - Those who don't make peace with their opponents before they are turned over to the judge, court and prison won't get out until they pay the last penny.
- Don't rely on oaths, but tell the truth.
- The only reward the people who put on a sad face so that others notice will notice their fasting and prayers, is - those people's notice.
- Christ had not found so great a faith in Israel as the captain who had great faith in Christ's authority (to heal).
- Judgment day will be better for Sodom and Gomorrah than for those who do not welcome or listen to the disciples sharing the good news.
- The son of man will come before his disciples and followers had gone to all the cities in Israel.
- Whoever gives one of Jesus' disciples a cup of cold water, will not lose their reward in heaven.
- The least important person in the kingdom of heaven is greater than John the Baptist. John is/was greater than all people born.
- Many prophets and many of God's people longed to see and hear what those who were with Christ saw: but they didn't see it or hear it.
- Many will not understand because they: grow callous, and/or close their eyes, ears and/or hearts. If they would turn back to God, He would heal them.
- People need to grow in faith – Do not: let Satan snatch the word, receive it with joy but not put down roots, or let worries and the deceitfulness of riches cloud it out. Receive it, water it and bring forth fruit.
- People standing there with Jesus would see the Son of Man coming in His kingdom.
- Small faith (a mustard seed of it) can move mountains.
- We must change and become like little children to enter the kingdom of Heaven.
- Our Father in Heaven does not want one little one to be lost.
- Whoever we imprison God imprisons and whoever we set free (through forgiveness and calling back to Him) God forgives.
- It will be hard for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven.
- When the Son of Man sits on his glorious throne in the world to come, you, my followers, will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Faith will cause negative situations to die (fig tree withered) or be overcome (mountains moved).
- Tax collectors and prostitutes will come into God's kingdom before those who say they believe, but are irritated and oppose Him and His work. Jesus is the rock the breaks us or that we build on.
- Yeshua answered him, “‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the greatest and most important commandment. The second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as you love yourself.’ All of Moses' Teachings and the Prophets depend on these two commandments.” (Matthew 22:37-40)
- Jesus will answer those that try to trap him with truth.
- Those who are warned for rejecting the truth and killing others are accountable for this and previous sins and bloodshed.

- Jesus wanted to gather Israel's children together like a hen gathers her chicks, they were not willing and did not see him until they said (say) 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord'.
- Stones of the buildings were (are) torn down and the generation with Jesus saw Christ and His work: but His words have not and will never pass away.
- When the Son of Man returns He will put wise and foolish servants in their proper place of punishment or reward.
- Whatever we do or do not do for one of my brothers or sisters, no matter how unimportant they seem, you did/do for me (Christ). Punishment will be meted for bad and reward will be given for things done for good.
- Wherever this Good News is spoken in the world, what the woman who anointed Jesus' head with expensive perfume in preparation for His burial has done/did will also be told in memory of her.
- Judas would betray Jesus.
- Peter would deny Him 3 times before the cock crowed – This is a time of day prior to dawn that marks the end of the night, when the temple crier called Levites and priests to their posts and service began. (hermeneutics.stackexchange.com) I think it symbolic that the denial, which was done in the dark, signifies the darkness that happens in our lives when we are denying God's truth. The dawn symbolizes the light that comes into our lives when we search and follow. Peter searched for Jesus when he ran to the tomb, welcomed and broke bread with Him on the road to Emmaus and jumped out of the boat to swim to Him. Peter knew he was restored when he ate breakfast with Jesus, answering His inquiries of love and accepting His assignment to feed God's lambs and sheep.

Mark

- "People will be forgiven for any sin or curse. But whoever curses the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven. He is guilty of an everlasting sin." Yeshua said this because the experts in Moses' Teachings had said that he had an evil spirit.
- "If these people are given a sign, it will be far different than what they want."
- The kingdom of God arrived in Power during the time of the people who stood with Jesus.
- Even a cup of water given by those who belong to Christ or in His name will bring a reward.
- If we do not receive the kingdom of God like a little child, we cannot enter into it.
- "Anyone who gave (gives) up ... home, brothers, sisters, mother, father, children, or fields because of me and the Good News ... will certainly receive homes, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and fields, along with persecutions. But in the world to come they will receive eternal life. But many who are first will be last, and the last will be first."
- "The first of all the commandments Mitzvah's is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you are to love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.'[e] This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: 'You are to love your neighbor as yourself.'[g] There is no other commandment greater than these (Combined NKJ & CJB)
- A poor widow giving her last alm(s) is far more than others who give more but not all.

Luke

- There were many widows in Elijah's time but he was only sent to Zarephath, in Sidon.
- A prophet is not accepted in His own town.
- One of the thieves on the cross said he and the other thief were there because they were getting what they deserved, but Jesus had not done anything wrong. He asked Jesus to remember him when He went into his kingdom, and Jesus said he would be with Him in paradise that day.

John

- John was not the light but came to declare the truth about the light so that everyone would become believers through his message.
- The Word became human flesh and lived, dwelt, made His dwelling among and with us. We saw, observed His glory Sh'khinah. It was the glory from - that the Father shares with (as) His one and only (begotten) Son, a glory full of kindness, grace and truth.
- The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. (Combined Versions NAS, CJB, NIV)
- John declared the truth about Him when he said loudly, "This is the person about whom I said, 'The one who comes after me was before me because He existed before I did.'" (Names of God Bible.)
- The Law(s) were given through Moses, but kindness and truth came (into existence), were realized through Yeshua the Messiah, Jesus Christ. (Combined Version)
- Nathan will see the sky open and God's angels going up and coming down to the Son of Man.
- No one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit.
- We know what we're talking about, and we confirm what we've seen. Yet, you don't accept our message.
- But anyone who lives by, practices the truth comes (in) to the light, so that his works, deeds may be shown to be, seen plainly that they are wrought or accomplished by or in God.
- "No one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above.(Jesus) Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life. Instead, he will see God's constant anger." (John)
- The woman at the well had 5 husbands and the one she was living with was not her husband.
- True worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth. The Father is looking for people to do so. God is a spirit. Those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.
- The Son cannot do anything on his own. He can do only what he sees the Father doing. Indeed, the Son does exactly what the Father does.
- "Those who listen to what I say and believe in the one who sent me will have eternal life. They won't be judged because they have already passed from death to life." (Names of God Bible)
- A time is coming (and is now here) when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who respond to it will live (NOG).
- Some were (are) not looking for Jesus because of miracles, but because of eating as much bread as they wanted.
- Moses gave bread (manna) but Jesus Father gave (gives) bread from heaven.
- Every believer has eternal life.
- The words of Jesus are spiritual full of Spirit and Life – some believe and some don't. For those who rely on Him, there is nowhere else we could or would go.
- You cannot have any life in you unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood [unless you appropriate His life and the saving merit of His blood.] John 6:53B (Amplified)
- The one who speaks on his own seeks his own glory; but he who seeks the glory of the one who sent him is true, and there is no unrighteousness in him. (CBS)
- "If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:31-32 (Combined Versions)
- Whoever lives a sinful life is a slave to sin.
- You come from your father, the devil, and you desire to do what your father wants you to do. The devil was a murderer from the beginning. He has never been truthful. He doesn't know what the truth is. Whenever he tells a lie, he's doing what comes naturally to him. He's a liar and the father of lies. John 8:44 (NOG)
- Some people will not believe Jesus because He speaks the truth.
- Whoever obeys what I say will never see death.

- Before Abraham was ever born, I am.
- The person who doesn't enter the sheep pen through the gate but climbs in somewhere else is a thief or a robber. Jesus said "I am the gate for the sheep."
- A single grain of wheat doesn't produce anything unless it is planted in the ground and dies. If it dies, it will produce a lot of grain. (NOG)
- Servants are not greater than their masters, and messengers are not superior to the people who send them.
- Whoever accepts me (Jesus) - accepts the one who sent me.
- "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one goes to the Father except through me."
- Those who believe in me will do the things that I am doing. They will do even greater things because I am going to the Father. (NOG)
- That helper, He is the Spirit of Truth. The world cannot accept him, is unable to receive Him, because it doesn't see or know him. You know him, because he lives, remains, abides with you and will be in you. (Combined versions)
- "The helper Counselor whom I will send to you from the Father will come. This helper, the Spirit of Truth who proceeds, comes from the Father, will testify, declare the truth about me, (on my behalf)" (Combined Versions)
- It's good for you, it is for your benefit, that I'm going away. If I don't go away, the helper won't come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. (Combined Versions)
- When the Spirit of Truth comes, he will guide you into the full, all, truth. He won't speak on his own. He will speak what he hears and will tell you about what things are to come. (Combined Versions)
- "Use the truth to make them holy. Sanctify them (set them apart for the purpose they are designed and designated for) by and in the truth Your word(s) are truth. (Combined Version)
- I'm dedicating myself to this holy work I'm doing for them, I sanctify myself for them, setting myself apart for holiness, so that they, too, may be sanctified by the truth, that is they will use the truth to be holy. (Combined Versions)
- Jesus asked of the guard, why, if He told the truth ... "Why did hit you me"? (Some people will react to the truth.)
- "You're correct in saying that I'm a king. I have been born and have come into the world for this reason: to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to, is of the truth listens to me." (Combined Versions)
- The man who saw tells the truth – it happened as was testified of in scripture "Not one of his bones will be broken." And "They will look at him whom they have pierced."
- When you were young, you would get ready to go where you wanted. But when you're old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will get you ready to take you where you don't want to go. (NOG) (So do what you should now.)
